Statement of Religious Beliefs Opposed to Immunizations for COVID-19

1. Romans 12:1- "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God." Therefore, I cannot use vaccines to protect me from something in the future because it shows a lack of trust and faith in God and His abilities to keep me well, as well as protect those around me.

4. 2 Corinthians 7:1 "Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God." I cannot take a vaccine because I believe it defiles my body and spirit with things God did not intend.

5. James 4:15- " For that ye ought to say, If the Lord will, we shall live, and do this, or that.

16 But now ye rejoice in your boastings: all such rejoicing is evil.

17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin."

I believe that God has made it clear to me how to keep my mind, body, and spirit clean. Believing that vaccines are unclean, I would be sinning and violating God's will

for my life by using them.

6. James 5:13- "Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms.

15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.
16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much."
As a Christian, I believe in the power of prayer. If I am afflicted with something, I know that I can pray to God Almighty and if it is His will, He can remove that affliction. If I am sick or in need then I need to pray and ask my church family to pray. Therefore, taking a vaccine shows my lack of faith in prayer and in God's divine power.
